

In an effort to comply with COVID-19 response guidelines issued by the State of California, McCloud Hotel has created the following tables to outline what is and is not permitted by the County and State. According to California’s “Blueprint for a Safer Economy”, Wedding Ceremonies fall under “Cultural Ceremonies” and are permitted statewide with modifications as outlined in the “Industry Guidelines for Places of Worship and Cultural Ceremonies”. Wedding Receptions/Celebrations on the other hand, fall under “Gatherings” and are NOT permitted. An order release by the California State Department of Health on 9/12/20 states that, “gatherings unless otherwise specified are not permitted across the state of California until further guidance is issued by the California Department of Public Health.” This means that wedding celebrations including dancing, DJ/band, photobooths, etc., are not permitted until further notice. In Lieu of a wedding reception, we are able to offer a banquet meal so long as “Industry Guidelines for Restaurants” are observed including the use of proper face coverings, social distancing, and limited capacity.

ALL WEDDING CEREMONY AND DINING OPTIONS MUST ADHERE TO STATE AND COUNTY SOCIAL DISTANCING RECOMMENDATIONS, AND FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS.

Guidelines for Weddings

County COVID Status	State Restrictions	State Guidelines
Widespread (purple)	Ceremony: Outdoor only Reception: Prohibited	Face coverings and social distancing required. Households to be seated together without mingling with others outside of the household.
Substantial (red)	Ceremony: Outdoor or indoor at 25% Capacity or 100 whichever is fewer Reception: Prohibited	Same as Widespread guidelines plus indoor capacity limited to 50 attendees.
Moderate (orange)	Ceremony: Outdoor or indoor at 50% Capacity or 200 whichever is fewer Reception: Prohibited	Same as Widespread guidelines plus indoor capacity limited to 100 attendees.
Minimal (yellow)	Ceremony: Outdoor or indoor at 50% Capacity or 200 whichever is fewer Reception: Prohibited	Same as Widespread guidelines plus indoor capacity limited to 100 attendees.

County COVID Status	State Restrictions	State Guidelines
Widespread (purple)	Outdoor Dining: Permitted Indoor Dining: Prohibited	Face coverings and social distancing. Bar area closed.
Substantial (red)	Outdoor Dining: Permitted Indoor Dining: 25% Capacity	Face covering and social distancing. Indoor capacity limited to 50 attendees. Bar area closed.
Moderate (orange)	Outdoor Dining: Permitted Indoor Dining: 50% Capacity	Face coverings and social distancing. Indoor capacity limited to 100 attendees. Bar area closed.
Minimal (yellow)	Outdoor Dining: Permitted Indoor Dining: 50% Capacity	Face coverings and social distancing. Indoor capacity limited to 100 attendees. Bar area open for walkup service.
